#### ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Delaware Military Academy is looking for a creative and dedicated Biology certified teacher to our 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students. The ideal candidate will hold a Delaware teaching certificate in secondary biology and have a minimum of three years of teaching experience. This teacher will also be teaching a half credit elective Food Science course for 10<sup>th</sup> graders.
