Today, we are closing on a loan with the USDA at a fixed rate of 2.375% for 30 years. This is a tremendous accomplishment for DMA in regards to our future financial outlook and we are now strategizing on how to transfer our entire debt service over to USDA. More to come!

The PSAT-10 will end earlier than the SAT at approximately 11:00 am; following the exam, sophomores will be housed in the Mess Hall until dismissal or you can provide them a note and pick them up at 11:00am. They are welcome to bring a bagged lunch, as lunches will not be sold. For most of the juniors, this will be their first time taking the SAT, which is an important step in determining their post-high school plans. For the sophomores, this exam will provide data about the progress made since 9th grade and the work that needs to be done in preparation for their SAT administration next year.
