#### ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Delaware Military Academy is looking for a certified secondary social studies teacher to start in August 2018. The ideal candidate will hold a Delaware teaching certificate in secondary social studies (with a strong background in economics) and have a minimum of three years of teaching experience. This teacher will also be teaching a senior elective called Asian Studies.
