Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Delaware Military Academy is looking for a dual certified teacher who can work as a part-time secondary math teacher as well as a part-time science teacher for our 9th-12th grade program. The ideal candidate will hold a Delaware teaching certificate in both secondary mathematics and secondary science and have a minimum of three years of teaching experience. The specific science content area will be determined based on the qualifications and experience of the candidates. Responsibilities include:

- Support the academic, social, emotional and leadership growth of each cadet
- Plan and deliver academic lessons that are aligned with the common core state standards
- Communicate (positively and growth opportunities) with parents on a regular basis
- Maintain grades in a timely manner
- Provide additional instruction, as needed, for struggling cadets
- Participate as part of a larger team of academic professionals to ensure the success of our cadets
- Provide support to cadets to ensure they are prepared for college entrance testing
- Become an integral part of the DMA program through extracurricular activities and professional development
