Non-Prescription Medications

School nurses may dispense non-prescription medications with parental permission. The following guidelines must be followed:

1. The school nurse must assess the child's complaint and symptoms to determine if other measures can be used before medication is administered.
2. The school nurse must be notified of any allergies, especially to medication that your child has.
3. All medications sent to the school nurse must be in the original container. (This is the law.)
