Summer Reading Assignment for both CP and Honors 11th Grade Literature Cadets

The following assignment is for ALL cadets enrolled in 11th grade CP or Honors Literature for the 2025-2026 school year. *(Cadets enrolled in AP Language & Composition have a different set of books and assignments.)*

This assignment must be completed and submitted by the end of the first week of school. Part of the assignment requires you to complete a journal based on tasks spread out over the course of several days. So don't wait until the last minute to complete it. The TYPED assignment must be submitted to TURNITIN.com by Friday, Sept. 5th at 3:00pm. All cadets will use the following TURNITIN.com code for submission:

Your assignment is to read the book, *How to Break up With Your Phone* by Catherine Price (ISBN = 039958112X). You can purchase the book, but if you send me an email at <u>colleen.bradely@dma.k12.de.us</u> I can send you a PDF of the text as well.

After reading the book, you will need to complete the Google Doc assignment using the following link: YOU MUST COPY THE LINK AND PASTE IT INTO YOUR BROWSER. YOU CANNOT SIMPLY CLICK.

Once you open the document, the first thing you should do is make a copy and rename it with your first and last name + summerwork (ie., Colleen Bradley summerwork). Make sure to complete ALL sections for each of the 5 tasks in RED. You will also see a grading rubric on the last page of the document. Once you've completed your document, you will be submitting it to TURNITIN.com. All of you should have a TURNITIN account from last year, but if you cannot retrieve it you can set up a new one with your DMA email. The assignment is already open on TURNITIN, so you can submit it at any time. THE FINAL DEADLINE FOR ALL SUBMISSIONS IS FRIDAY, SEPT. 5th AT 3PM.

The skills you practice with the assignment and the material you compile will be used to write our first paper. So failing to complete this assignment will also have a negative impact on future assignments
