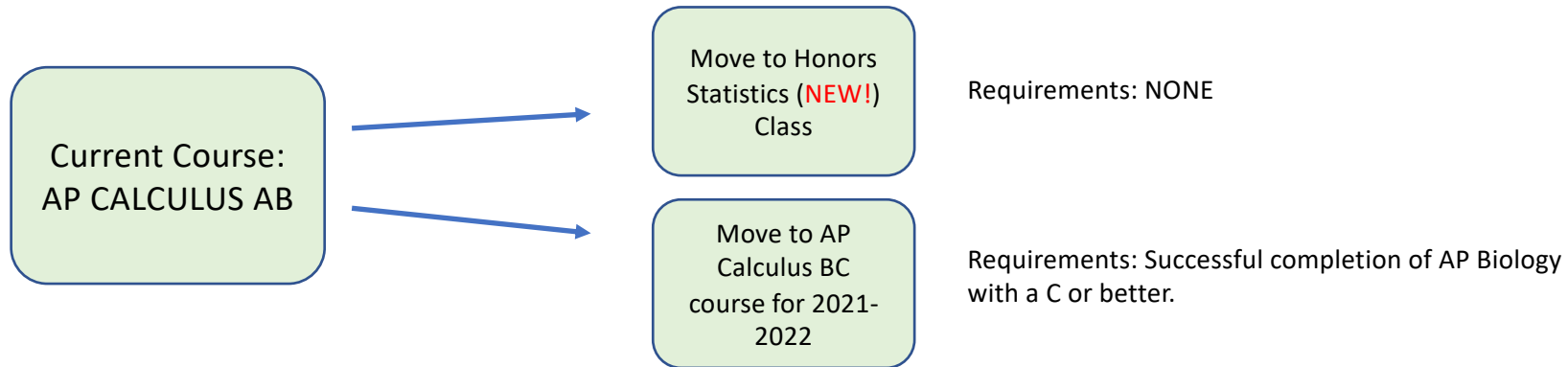
## PROGRESSION OF MATH COURSES
