DELMARVA POST SOCIETY OF AMERICAN MILITARY ENGINEERS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

PURPOSE:

The Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) is a non-profit association of professional engineers from all the Armed Forces and from all fields of engineering practice in the private sector. Dedicated to the National Defense, SAME's mission is to bring the Nation's engineers together in peacetime to advance military engineering knowledge, promote efficiency in the military services, and develop a spirit of cooperation between the engineering profession in the private sector and that of the military so that they can be effectively engaged in emergencies. This scholarship is intended to further SAME's goal of "Building Engineers for National Defense".

CRITERIA:

- I. Available to high school seniors or other incoming first year college freshman from the DelMarVa area who have been accepted into the engineering program of a four-year, ABET accredited college. Candidate shall be a Senior at a high school, or have a primary residence for one continuous full year prior to the application deadline, located in Delaware, on the Eastern Shore (below the C&D Canal) of Maryland or on the Eastern Shore of Virginia.
- II. Candidate shall be accepted into or have applied to enroll in the engineering program of a four (4) year, ABET accredited college.
- III. Candidate shall be a citizen of the United States of America at the time of application.
- IV. Candidate shall submit a completed application form, including essay, to arrive at the designated destination no later than 4:30 p.m. local time on March 31 of the year of graduation.

AWARD:

- I. The amount of the award shall be determined annually by the Board of Directors of the Delmarva Post.
- II. The award shall be a one-time presentation.
- III. The successful candidate shall be notified by May 15 of the graduation year. Unsuccessful candidates shall not be notified.

- IV. All applications shall be considered, however, the Delmarva Post reserves the right to reject any and all candidates for any reason, and not offer the scholarship Award in any given year.
- V. Candidates shall be evaluated on the information submitted per the instructions of the application. The Delmarva Post Board of Directors may, at their sole discretion, appoint a Scholarship Award Selection Committee to review the applications and determine the successful candidate.
- VI. At the discretion of the Delmarva Post, interviews may be conducted to determine the successful candidate. These interviews may be held in person or on the telephone.
- VII. Applicants or a member of their family do <u>not</u> need to be members of SAME. However, SAME affiliation may be considered when evaluating the applications.

PRESENTATION:

The award, in its full amount, shall be presented to the successful candidate at the regular monthly luncheon meeting of the Delmarva Post in June, July or August, or at the candidate's high school awards ceremony, as determined by the Board of Directors.
