## Behavioral Commitment Agreement

All cadets attending a DMA activity, on or off campus, are expected to demonstrate appropriate behavior. All Academy rules and policies — including dress code — are enforced at all school-sponsored activities.

Please review the following expectations:

- The use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- All guests must be under the age of 21.
- Guests will not be admitted without their sponsoring DMA cadet.
- Dress must be formal wear (i.e. formal gown, tuxedo).
- Dancing must be appropriate.
- DMA cadets are responsible for the behavior and demeanor of their guest.
- DMA reserves the right to refuse entrance to or dismiss anyone from the prom.
- All attendees of Delaware Military Academy's prom are to stay in the area of the venue designated for our event ONLY. – If you are found to exit our designated area, you will be dismissed from the event.
- Guests must present a valid school ID or state issued ID at the door. A copy can also be turned in with this form.
- Bags larger than a small clutch will not be permitted.
- If a cadet or guest is sent home for violating this agreement, **no refund will be given.**
