TITLE IX Policy

Title IX of the federal Education Amendments of 1972 is the major federal statute prohibiting sex discrimination in education. All Delaware public schools and institutions of higher education receiving federal funding are required to adhere to Title IX.

Title IX states:

“No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any educational program or activity receiving federal assistance.”

The Delaware Department of Education and all Delaware public school districts and charter schools are each required to have a Title IX coordinator to manage Title IX implementation and adherence.
